### **Industrial Independent School District Seeking G/T Students**

The Industrial Independent School District is in the process of identifying Kindergarten through twelfth grade students for the district's Gifted and Talented Program designed to meet the needs of students according to the state's definition of a "student who, by virtue of outstanding mental abilities, is capable of high performance. The student may demonstrate, singularly or in combination, above-average achievement or potential in such areas as general intellectual ability, specific subject matter aptitude..."

The Industrial ISD serves identified students in grades K-5 using a general intellectual approach and in 6-12 in the content areas of language arts, math, science, and social studies. After a student is nominated, he/she must meet Board approved district criteria based on screening documents and committee review.

Any parent or teacher who chooses to nominate a student in grades K-12 may do so by completing the nomination form. Parents may secure a nomination form and characteristics of a gifted and talented student from the campus principal where their student(s) attends.
